

Exhibitor Dress Code

The following code will be enforced during fair hours unless noted otherwise

1. Vulgar, illegal, (including weapons, alcohol, drugs, and tobacco) and/or sexually oriented statements or suggestions on clothing, jewelry, buttons, or accessories are not permitted. Any dress or statement, which may cause a hostile, intimidating, degrading, offensive, harassing, or discriminatory environment, is prohibited.
2. Shorts and skirts will have hems and will be no shorter than the middle of the thigh. Shirts and tops will be no lower than the collarbone must have sleeves and must be long enough to be tucked in. Low cut tops, see-through clothing, tank tops, spaghetti straps, and shorts or skirts shorter than the middle of the thigh are examples of styles that are considered unacceptable for exhibitors.
3. See-through clothing is not permitted. Clothing that is ripped, torn, or has holes in it is not permitted. All undergarments are to be covered.
4. Oversized clothing, which compromises the safety of exhibitors, is not permitted.
5. Exhibitors must wear closed toed shoes, no sandals, flip flops, or open heeled shoes permitted. This rule will be enforced at all times while exhibitor is on the St. Lucie County Fairgrounds.
6. Failure to comply with dress code will result in the exhibitor being sent home to change. Exhibitor must still comply with livestock schedule.
